

**ORDINANCE NO. 08-2022**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF ADDITIONAL SALARY FUNDING FOR OVERTIME FOR THE STREETS DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary to appropriate additional funds for the overtime incurred by Street Department employees due to the number of winter snowfalls; and

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg prides itself on offering a high level of service to our residents including keeping City roadways clear and safe, but that level of service can come with extra hours worked by our employees; and

WHEREAS, without the appropriation of additional funds, the Streets Overtime fund will be depleted with any future heavy snowfall.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:


Section 1. That an amount of \$25,000.00 in the unappropriated Street Fund (260) be and is hereby appropriated to account 260.268.5105 Street Overtime.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate financial needs of the City to transfer funds due to the depleted overtime services fund account. Upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon the signature of the Mayor.
