

ORDINANCE NO. 21-2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EMH&T TO CONDUCT DESIGN, ENGINEERING, AND BIDDING SERVICES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WEST PARKING LOT LIGHTING SERVICES, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, EMH&T will provide engineering, design, and assistance with bidding services for the Police Department west parking lot lighting services; and

Whereas, the design of this project was approved in 2021; however, that included reusing the existing security lighting. It has been determined that parts and renovation of the existing lighting will not be possible; and

Whereas, due to the need for new security lighting, additional funding of \$6,400.00 must be appropriated from the America Rescue Plan Act (ARPA).


NOW, THEREFORE; BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO, that:


Section 1. That the Mayor authorize EMH&T to conduct design, engineering, and bidding services for the police department west parking lot security lighting project.


Section 2. That an amount of \$6,500.00 be approved and taken from the unappropriated American Rescue Plan Fund (CIP) (206) and be appropriated to account 206.000.5659 Miscellaneous Infrastructure.

Section 3. This Ordinance, being an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the financial needs of the City, shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage by Council and the signature of the Mayor.
