

ORDINANCE NO. 37-2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH EMH&T FOR PROGRAM VERIFICATION AND SCHEMATIC DESIGN FOR THE BRICE PARK DEVELOPMENT, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg is working in a collaborative effort with the City of Columbus to develop a passive park at 1455 Brice Road; and

WHEREAS, as part of that collaboration, the City of Reynoldsburg will be responsible for the development and design of the park; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance will direct the City engineering firm of EMH&T to complete program verification and schematic design for this project

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into contract with EMH&T, in the amount of \$69,270.00, for program verification and schematic design of this project.


SECTION 2. That \$69,270.00 be appropriated from the unappropriated American Recovery Plan Fund and appropriated to account number 206.000.5529 Miscellaneous Distributions.


SECTION 3. That when the City of Columbus reimburses the Reynoldsburg for these expenses, an amount of \$69,270.00 be appropriated to the unappropriated American Recovery Plan Fund (206).

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city, and further that the agreement be completed to finalize agreements with the City of Columbus; wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon the signature by the Mayor.
