

**ORDINANCE NO. 43-2022**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH EMH&T FOR CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES RELATING TO THE EAST MAIN STREET PHASE II IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (JACKSON STREET TO WAGGONER ROAD), APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, EMH&T will provide construction inspection services for the East Main Street (Jackson Street to Waggoner Road) Improvement Project Phase II. The proposed improvements include replacing the existing 1930's era storm sewer, new curb and sidewalks, resurfacing of roadway as well as the addition of unified streetscape entrancement's including new street lights, benches, street trees, tree wells, etc.; and

WHEREAS, EMH&T's proposal for these services is \$231,196.00 (total appropriation) to be unappropriated from the City's Capital Improvement Fund (CIP) (410).


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into contract with EMH&T for construction inspection services related to the East Main Street Improvement Project Phase II (Jackson Street to Waggoner Road).

SECTION 2. That an amount of \$231,196.00 from the unappropriated Capital Improvement Fund (410) be appropriated to account 410.000.0182.5659 East Main Street Improvement Project Phase II Miscellaneous Infrastructure.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the City and further to have the agreement in place as soon as possible; wherefore, upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
