

ORDINANCE NO. 45-2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR U.S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY FOR A WATER LEVEL MONITORING DEVICE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg has experienced instances of severe weather resulting in flooding in areas adjacent to Blacklick Creek; and

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg is investigating both short and long term solutions to issues facing our residents due to extreme weather events; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of the Interior U.S. Geological Survey and the City of Reynoldsburg in partnership present a proposal for a water level monitoring device that will allow early warning to residents of potential flooding due to extreme weather events; and

WHEREAS, the cost shall be shared between the U.S. Department of the Interior U.S. Geological Survey and the City of Reynoldsburg for a total shared amount of \$25,000 for 2022 with the City of Reynoldsburg's share being \$12,500.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO;


SECTION 1: The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with the U.S. Department of the Interior U.S. Geological Survey for a water level monitoring Device for Blacklick Creek for 2022.

SECTION 2. That, in accepting this award, the City also accepts the shared cost of the monitoring device for of \$12,500 in 2022.

SECTION 3. That funds appropriated from the unappropriated General Fund (110) to account 110.448.5339 Miscellaneous Contract Services.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the health and safety of the City to install the device to address the potential flooding; wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
