

ORDINANCE NO. 56-2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STRAWSER PAVING COMPANY PERTAINING TO THE 2022 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (CONTRACT A), ALTERNATE #11 REYNOLDSBURG POLICE DEPARTMENT WEST PARKING LOT, APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg received multiple bids for the 2022 Street Improvement Project (Contract A) including Alternate #11 Reynoldsburg Police Department West Parking Lot Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the proposals submitted and determined that the lowest and best bidder for this project is Strawser Paving Company; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has also concluded that Strawser Paving Company has the ability, resources, experience to properly complete this project, and recommended that the contract for the 2022 Street Improvements Project (Contract A), Alternate #11 Reynoldsburg Police Department West Parking Lot Improvements be awarded to Strawser Paving Company in the amount of \$1,393,332.50.

NOW, THEREFORE; BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO, that:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Strawser Paving Company for the 2022 Street Improvement Project (Contract A) including Alternate #11 Reynoldsburg Police Department West Parking Lot Improvements as follows:

Alternate #11 Reynoldsburg Police Department West Parking Lot Improvements \$1,393,332.50

Contingency (8%):	<u>\$ 111,466.00</u>
GRAND TOTAL	<u>\$ 1,504,798.50</u>


SECTION 2. That the following appropriations shall be made in an amount of \$1,354,798.50 from the unappropriated American Rescue Act Fund (206) to account number 206.000.5659 Miscellaneous Infrastructure. Additionally, an amount of \$150,000.00 from the unappropriated Federal Forfeiture Fund (294) be appropriated to account 294.111.5659 Miscellaneous Infrastructure.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the City, and further so that construction can begin as soon as possible in order to be completed this year; wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
