

**ORDINANCE NO. 69-2022**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH EMH&T FOR ENGINEERING AND PERMITTING SERVICES FOR THE BLACKLICK CREEK STREAM RESTORATION AND TRAIL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, EMH&T, the City's engineer, will complete the design, engineering, permitting, and bidding services for this project.

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg has been approved for grants from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program for the Blacklick Creek Stream Restoration and Trail Improvement; and

WHEREAS, the grants received are reimbursable grants for project expenses.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into contract with EMH&T, in the amount of \$161,800, for the design, engineering services, permitting, and bidding services for this stream restoration and trail improvement project.


SECTION 2. That \$161,800.00 be appropriated from the unappropriated Capital Improvement Fund (CIP 410) and be appropriated into account number 410.000.0192.5659 Miscellaneous Infrastructure.


SECTION 3. That \$161,800.00 from the, reimbursable grants, when received, shall be appropriated to account number 410.000.0192.4335 Grants.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the City's government and to meet contract deadlines. Wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
