

ORDINANCE NO. 80-2022

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED IT
COMPUTER FUND TO AN ACCOUNT IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg Police Department was authorized by Ordinance 171-2021 to purchase software and hardware for a license plate detection system from Flock; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the system is fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000.00) and included in the 2022 Budget; and

WHEREAS, those funds were budgeted into the IT Computer Fund and need to be appropriated to a fund in the Police Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That an amount of \$55,000.00 be appropriated from the unappropriated IT Computer Fund 110.584.5366 Computer Maintenance and appropriated to Police Department account number 110.111.5639 Other Equipment.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the City, and further to expedite the purchase of the equipment and software to meet contact timelines; wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
