

ORDINANCE NO. 83-2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR THE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR DISPARATE FUNDING AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg, City of Whitehall, City of Columbus, and Franklin County are eligible for a grant from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Understanding is necessary for the receipt of this grant as Franklin County is not eligible, but is responsible for more than fifty percent of the costs associated with prosecution and/or incarceration of individuals from each of these aforementioned cities; and

WHEREAS, this agreement will allow for the equitable distribution of funds between all parties.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to sign a Memorandum of Understanding with Franklin County, the City of Columbus, and the City of Whitehall to receive the 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Program grant.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety and further to meet agreement deadlines; wherefore upon adoption by Council this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
