

ORDINANCE NO. 84-2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE 2022 WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the 2022 water line replacement project is for waterlines on Saratoga Avenue and Saratoga Court as a base bid with Alternate Bid 4 to complete East Main Street; and

WHEREAS, the upgrading and repair of the water lines would provide added protection against the failure of the existing water distribution system; and

WHEREAS, the upgrading waterlines will serve to satisfy the Ohio EPA Director's Final Findings and Orders (DFFO).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Danbert, Inc. with a base bid of \$603,238.65 for construction services and a construction contingency of \$60,324.00 for a total base bid cost of \$663,562.65 for the 2022 waterline replacement project.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Danbert, Inc. for the following alternate bid:

Bid 4 – Total cost \$76,222.73 (\$69,292.73 bid with a \$6,930 contingency)


SECTION 3. That total project costs in the amount of \$739,785.38 should be appropriated from the unappropriated CIP Water Fund (710) to account 710.000.0190.5621 2022 Waterline Project.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the City's government and to allow for a 2022 completion. Wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
