

ORDINANCE NO. 91-2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE VARIOUS CITY JEDD AGREEMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg, Ohio has five separate JEDD agreements that require distribution to multiple municipalities and other collaborative entities; and

WHEREAS, it has been deemed necessary to appropriate additional funds to three of the JEDD agreements in order to make all necessary distributions to members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO OF FRANKLIN, LICKING, AND FAIRFIELD COUNTIES, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That JEDD 1, 4, and 7 require distribution of funds to all members associated with the JEDD agreements on a quarterly basis.

SECTION 2. That the following appropriations be made from the unappropriated JEDD funds:

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the City, and further to allow for the acceptance and distribution of JEDD funds, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
